- We will have our TMEA Region Band Concert this Friday. We have Victoria Sharp, Alberto Fuentes, Landon Tabb, and Bruno Ruano who will be participating. The information below is for those students.
- 1. While on our campus, *please* have your students **wear band gear** from their own HS band program (ex: Brandeis band show shirt, or O'Connor band jacket. This will help with campus pride, but also visually linking guests on our campus to their home campus.
- 2. **Personal equipment and item storage** will be in the auditorium seats this year as it has been in the past. Students should leave items at their own risk- although we don't anticipate any issues with this, we all know we can't babysit each and every possession our students bring. If it is valuable, please encourage them to keep it with themselves through the day.



3. **Lunch:** students are permitted to leave campus for lunch or bring their own. There will be a designated area for students staying to eat which is *not* in the band halls. After they have eaten their lunch, students are requested to go into the auditorium seats to socialize with one another and alleviate the crowding of the hallways.

4. School Entry:

-Thursday PM: All students and staff are to enter through the BAND HALL ENTRANCE on the side of the Taft building. NOT in the main front entrance. There will be a Taft Band Director letting students into this entryway.

-Friday AM: All students are to enter through the FRONT ENTRYWAY of the school on this day. This is different from Thursday, and especially different from past years. This is a specific request of my administration, so please clearly communicate to your students and we will remind them on Thursday night.

- 5. If you have a student participating in the clinic/concert, you **MUST** have a director from your school on site at all times, including lunch. You are also asked to have your NISD employee badge on you at all times when you are here on campus. This has been an issue in the past. Please talk with your own campus staff and create a schedule to ensure that there is a director on campus at all times during times that your students are here. If there are issues with a student's behavior or health, that director team will be the first point of contact.
- 6. Students who are attending are responsible for getting their own transportation to Taft.
